



## High Commission of the Republic of Mauritius - CANBERRA

### **INFORMATION NOTE: APPLICATION FOR TRAVEL DOCUMENT IN AUSTRALIA**

**Note: A Travel Document is valid for a single journey to Mauritius, and it is applied in case of an emergency due to expired or lost passport.**

To apply for a Travel Document, applicants are requested to forward to the Mauritius High Commission the duly filled-in "*Application for a Mauritius Passport*" Form (P.F.136)

2. The following should be submitted along with the application form:
  - a. Money Order/Cheque for **AUS\$ 22.00** drawn in favour of the **Mauritius High Commission**
  - b. Letter stating reason/s for application for a Travel Document
  - c. 2 identical passport sized photographs
  - d. blank registered post envelope or arrangement by courier service as applicable, in the event that applicant cannot pick up travel document in-person
  
3. The applicant is also required to submit certified true copies of the following:
  - (a) Birth Certificate
  - (b) Marriage/Divorce Certificate (if applicable)
  - (c) Passport, (Pages 1-5) (if applicable)
  - (e) National Identity Card of Mauritius
  - (f) Residency Status in Australia- visa/Certificate of Citizenship
  - (g) Naturalisation/Registration Certificate (where applicable)
  - (h) Statutory Declaration from the Police for Lost Property (for lost passport) with signature of Police Officer and seal of Police Station
  - (i) Proposed travel itinerary
  
4. Application for a Travel Document for **Minors** should **also** be accompanied by:
  - (a) Birth Certificate (of applicant and of parents)
  - (b) Marriage/Divorce Certificate (of parents).
  - (c) Letter of Consent from both parents in case of minors. Consent of parents may be obtained/certified either before a Police Officer in a Police Station or at the Mauritius High Commission or at the office of a Legal Authority with the name of the officer clearly written and with an official seal affixed thereon.
  - (d) Passport, (Pages 1-5) (if applicable and those of parents)
  - (e) National Identity Card of Mauritius (of parents, if any)
  - (f) Residency Status in Australia- visa/Certificate of Citizenship (of parents)
  - (g) Naturalisation/Registration Certificate (where applicable)

- (h) Statutory Declaration from the Police for Lost Property (for lost passport) with signature of Police Officer and seal of Police Station
- (i) Proposed travel itinerary

The applicant is required to call in person at the Mauritius High Commission or at one of our Consulates to collect the Travel Document. The attention of applicants is drawn to the Sixth Schedule (Regulation 21) of the Passport Regulation 1969, the issuing authority of a Travel Document should certify that the photograph and signature on the Travel Document are those of the bearer, that is, the applicant should be physically present before the issuing authority either at the Mauritius High Commission in Canberra or our Honorary Consulates in Australia.
