Further to your request please be informed that a 'Landing Permit of Mortal Remains' must be obtained from the Ministry of Health & Wellness of the Republic of Mauritius prior to repatriation to Mauritius.

Please be informed that a 'Landing Permit of Mortal Remains' must be obtained from the Ministry of Health & Wellness of the Republic of Mauritius prior to repatriation to Mauritius.

You are therefore required to submit to the Mauritius High Commission copy of the following documents:

- (a) Letter of Request from Funeral Director/Parlour or relative
- (b) Passport of the deceased
- (c) Identity Card of the deceased
- (d) Birth Certificate (Not Mandatory)
- (e) Death Certificate mentioning cause of death
- (f) Coroner's Cremation Permit
- (g) Order authorizing disposal of a body (if available)
- (h) Transit Certificate (if available)
- (i) Non-Infectious Certificate
- (j) Certificate of Embalming
- (k) Sealing Certificate from Funeral Director certifying **that the coffin is "hermetically sealed"** (Mandatory)
- (l) Letter of Undertaking from family of the deceased to cover costs of repatriation

Upon receipt of the 'Landing Permit of Mortal Remains', the Mauritius High Commission will forward same to you.
